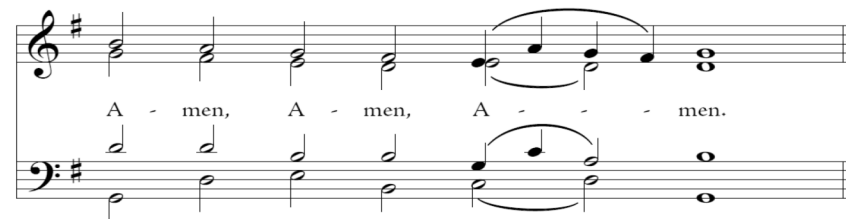

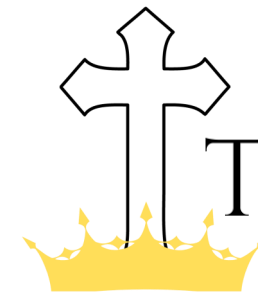

Pastor: Dearly beloved, if we say we have no sin we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us, but if we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Therefore, I pray and beseech you, as many as are here present, to accompany me with a pure heart and humble voice unto the throne of heavenly grace.

Come, let us worship and bow down!

And kneel before the Lord our Maker. (If you are able, please kneel)

Pastor: Most merciful God,

All: We come to You through Jesus, Who is our hope and the only Mediator between You and all humanity. We have hope in Your Son, Who was given to demonstrate Your love, Your glory, and Your adoption of us. We confess our sins of laziness, for we have not been diligent to pursue You and Your ways. We have neglected Your word and prayer. Instead of being conformed to the image of Your Son, we are confirmed in our own ways. Instead of trusting You, we trust ourselves. Instead of hearing You, we demand that others hear us. For these sins, and for those we now confess to You, shower us with Your mercy as You hear and forgive... (continue kneeling in silent confession)

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Pastor: Rise and hear the good news of God's forgiveness!

The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness. He has not dealt with us according to our sins nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. On this day know surely your sins are forgiven through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Thanks be to God. Our sins are forgiven in Jesus' name. Amen!

Plead my cause, O Lord, with those who strive with me;
