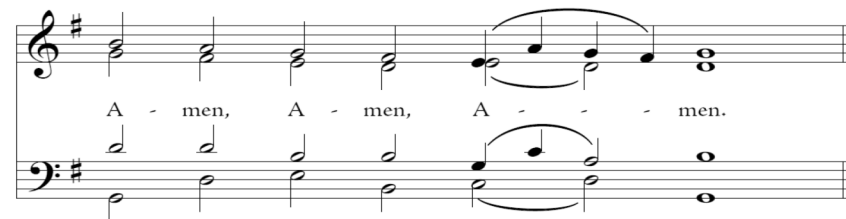

## OUR GOD CALLS US TO WORSHIP HIM & CLEANSSES US

† *Leader:* Let us worship God, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving.

† **Congregational Singing:** *Behold the Glories of the Lamb*—296

*Pastor:* Dearly beloved, if we say we have no sin we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us, but if we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Therefore, I pray and beseech you, as many as are here present, to accompany me with a pure heart and humble voice unto the throne of heavenly grace.

Come, let us worship and bow down!

**And kneel before the Lord our Maker.** (If you are able, please kneel)

*Pastor:* Most merciful God,

**All: We come to You through Jesus, the only Mediator, and the One Who died for us. We ask that You continue being merciful to us and forgive us our sins. We confess that we have not delighted in Your Word as we should. We confess that our lives have not been inclined to Your commandments. We confess our sin of attending to that which is worthless; in so doing, we neglect You, the fountain of living waters. In our sin, we have fallen short of Your glory. Grant us Your mercy and grace so that we may forsake our sins. Hear us now as we confess our sins to You.....(continue kneeling in silent confession)**

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

*Pastor:* Rise and hear the good news of God's forgiveness!

The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness. He has not dealt with us according to our sins nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. On this day know surely your sins are forgiven through Jesus Christ our Lord.

**Thanks be to God. Our sins are forgiven in Jesus' name. Amen!**

† *Pastor:* Christians in Whom do you believe?

**I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible; and in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father; by whom all things were made.**

**Who for us men and for our salvation came down from Heaven, and was incarnate by the Holy Ghost of the virgin Mary, and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate; He suffered and was buried; and the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures, and ascended into Heaven, and sits on the right hand of the Father; and He shall come again, with glory, to judge both the living and the dead; whose kingdom shall have no end.**

**And I believe in the Holy Ghost, the Lord and Giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son; who with the Father and the Son together is worshipped and glorified; who spoke by the Prophets.**

**And I believe one holy catholic\* and apostolic Church; acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins; and I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come.**
