Pastor: Dearly beloved, if we say we have no sin we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us, but if we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Therefore, I pray and beseech you, as many as are here present, to accompany me with a pure heart and humble voice unto the throne of heavenly grace.

And kneel before the Lord our Maker. (If you are able, please kneel)

Pastor: Most merciful God,

All: We come to You through Jesus, Who is the Word made flesh, and through Whom comes forgiveness and life. We confess our sins, knowing that all things are open and exposed before You. Nothing is hidden from Your gaze. You have called us to faithfulness in bearing Your name, and each of our sins is contrary to that calling. We have not loved others as we ought; certainly not as You have loved us. We have sought our own ways, and have failed to serve others. We have held on to that which is evil, and failed to adhere to the good. You know us fully, and we seek Your gracious pardon. Grant us Your grace which is greater than our sins. Hear us, and cover us with Your mercy, even now, as we continue in prayer, confessing our sins to You... (continue kneeling in silent confession)

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Pastor: Rise and hear the good news of God's forgiveness!

The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness. He has not dealt with us according to our sins nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. On this day know surely your sins are forgiven through Jesus Christ our Lord.
