OUR GOD CALLS US TO WORSHIP HIM & CLEANSSES US

Pastor: Dearly beloved, if we say we have no sin we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us, but if we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Therefore, I pray and beseech you, as many as are here present, to accompany me with a pure heart and humble voice unto the throne of heavenly grace.

Come, let us worship and bow down!

And kneel before the Lord our Maker. (If you are able, please kneel)

Pastor: Most merciful God,

All: We seek Your grace and pardon, and we do so as Your children. You know us, and You know our sin. You know our thoughts, and the desires of our hearts. You know that we have followed our sinful desires, and have not followed the example of Jesus. We confess our sins of laziness in Your Word, trust in ourselves, and neglect of holiness. Forgive us for blaming others for our sins, and for not dealing with our own impure desires. Because of this, we are in need of Your pardon and renewal. Grant us the encouragement of Your Holy Spirit to put away sin and pursue Your ways. Hear us, as we continue in prayer, confessing our sins... (continue kneeling in silent confession)

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Pastor: Rise and hear the good news of God's forgiveness!

The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness. He has not dealt with us according to our sins nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. On this day know surely your sins are forgiven through Jesus Christ our Lord.
