

Save me, O God! Scripture Lesson from the Old Testament For the waters have come up to my neck. Exodus 6:1-9 I sink in deep mire, where there is no standing; I have come into deep waters, where the floods overflow me. I am weary with my crying; my throat is dry; My eyes fail while I wait for my God. Those who hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of my head: They are mighty who would destroy me, being my enemies wrongfully; Though I have stolen nothing. I still must restore it. O God, You know my foolishness; And my sins are not hidden from You. Let not those who wait for You, O Lord God of hosts, be ashamed because of me; Let not those who seek You be confounded because of me, O God of Israel. Because for Your sake I have borne reproach: Shame has covered my face. I have become a stranger to my brothers, And an alien to my mother's children; Because zeal for Your house has eaten me up, And the reproaches of those who reproach You have fallen on me. When I wept and chastened my soul with fasting, That became my reproach. I also made sackcloth my garment; I became a byword to them. Those who sit in the gate speak against me, and I am the song of the drunkards. But as for me, my prayer is to You, O Lord, in the acceptable time; O God, in the multitude of Your mercy, hear me in the truth of Your salvation. Deliver me out of the mire, and let me not sink; Let me be delivered from those who hate me, and out of the deep waters. Let not the floodwater overflow me. Nor let the deep swallow me up; and let not the pit shut its mouth on me.

And I believe one holy catholic* and apostolic Church; acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins: and I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come.
