Pastor: Most merciful God,

Pardon us for our thoughts and desires which are evil; You know us fully. Grant us Your forgiving grace for not zealously adhering to what is good. Forgive our laziness in prayer, our dullness in Your ways, and our failure to build up one another in love. By Your Holy Spirit, prompt us to love and good deeds, and do not let our sins have dominion over us. In Your kindness, hear and forgive, as we continue in prayer, confessing our sins to You...(continue kneeling in silent confession)

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Pastor: Rise and hear the good news of God's forgiveness!

The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness. He has not dealt with us according to our sins nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. On this day know surely your sins are forgiven through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Thanks be to God. Our sins are forgiven in Jesus' name. Amen!
