*Pastor:* Our mouths will speak the praise of the Lord!





LORD'S DAY COLLECT

† **Congregational Singing:** *Open Now Thy Gates of Beauty* — 507

*Pastor:* Dearly beloved, if we say we have no sin we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us, but if we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Therefore, I pray and beseech you, as many as are here present, to accompany me with a pure heart and humble voice unto the throne of heavenly grace.

Come, let us worship and bow down!

**And kneel before the Lord our Maker.** (If you are able, please kneel in silent confession)

*Pastor:* Let us humbly confess our sins unto Almighty God,

**All: Almighty and most merciful Father, we have erred, and strayed from Thy ways like lost sheep. We have followed too much the devices and desires of our own hearts. We have offended against Thy holy laws. We have left undone those things which we ought to have done; and we have done those things which we ought not to have done; and there is no health in us. But Thou, O Lord, have mercy upon us, miserable offenders. Spare Thou those, O God, who confess their faults. Restore Thou those who are penitent; according to Thy promises declared unto mankind in Christ Jesus our Lord. And grant, O most merciful Father, for His sake; that we may hereafter live a godly, righteous, and sober life, to the glory of Thy holy Name. Amen.**

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

*Pastor:* Rise and hear the good news of God's forgiveness!

The Apostle Paul says that it is a faithful saying, worthy of all acceptance, that,

**Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost.**

## OUR GOD INVITES US TO HIS TABLE

We declare a portion of our faith — *The Nicene Creed*

† *Pastor:* Christians in Whom do you believe?

**I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible; and in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father; by whom all things were made.**
